Other Allowable Expenses (made at the request of the student):

1. Day Care (allowed for after-school care for school age children and all-day care for non-school age children)

4. Housing cost is based on living off campus. The Living Allowance component of the COA is constructed based on reasonable average expenses for a single student's housing and meals. It is also based on the actual months of enrollment and cannot cover months of non-enrollment, such as the time between academic years. The Living Allowance is adjusted for students living at home with their parents. Allowances for spouses or dependents of independent students are not included in the student's COA.
